

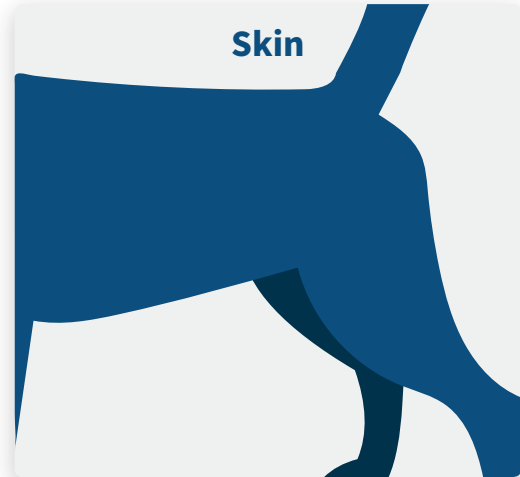

Prevent:	Control:	Combat:
Anti-flea products such as a pipette, collar or spray	Check your pet with a flea comb when he's itching or licking excessively	Anti-flea products such as a pipette, collar or spray

Prevent:	Control:	Combat:
Tick repellent products such as a pipette, collar or spray	Check your pet daily, especially the ears, armpits and groin	Remove the tick as soon as possible with the help of tick tweezers

## Ticks...

- ... occur in forests, heaths, dunes, parks and gardens
- ... suck blood and could transfer Lyme disease
- ... are here all year round, but mostly active when it's 7 degrees or higher
- ... are preventable with the right protection, such as a pipette, spray or collar
- ... need to be removed as soon as possible with tick tweezers to prevent illness

## Fleas...

- ... live on your pet's skin. The larva live in the environment
- ... cause uncomfortable itching, which can cause serious problems
- ... are detectable with a flea comb. You can prevent and kill fleas with a pipette, spray or collar
- ... eggs and larvae live in the environment, so don't forget to clean your house with a special cleaning spray
